

## APPENDIX: Jesus and Prophecy; what has been fulfilled, what is yet to come

### ALREADY: what has been fulfilled

Scholars have added up the Old Testament references that have been fulfilled by Jesus' first coming: there are over 350 of them. This chart highlights some key ones. The mathematical probability that any man could fulfill, let alone even arrange these markers is beyond possible.
